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
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"One Day International Seminar on Entrepreneur"

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

Dr. Manoj Rao has given the welcome Address and Theme of the Webinar.




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
Central India College of Business Management & Studies conducted online workshop on "Importance of Online Courses Conducted by National Coordinators Swayam/NPTEL".

To achieve this, the law gives people and businesses property rights to the information and intellectual goods they create, usually for a limited period of time. 
